Details for Teachers and Competitors:

Choose the appropriate level as outlined below according to the book you are using regardless of your pupils' ages

- 1. Minimus 1 = Medusa
- 2. Minimus 2 = Pegasus

Note to teachers – we would normally expect pupils who enter the competition in successive years to be at Level 1 the first time and at Level 2 the second time. Should it take longer than an academic year to complete Book 1 please specify this on your entry details.

The organiser reserves the right to disqualify any entry that does not meet these criteria.

Choose your category from the three below.

- 1. Art eg drawing, collage, painting, mosaic, handicraft (- Teachers please provide on a word document a list of named entries with a description of materials used by each entrant)
- 2. Creative Writing eg poem, prose, retelling story in 1st person, playwriting (SAVED AS PDF rather than word doc)
- 3. Drama to be submitted (in LATIN) on DVD with written script and cast list.

PLEASE show ONLY pupil's FIRST name on the front of the work as the winning entries will ultimately appear on our website and it is inappropriate to display full names of pupils.

A maximum of 10 entries, at each level may be submitted by each school/club. Each entry in categories 1 and 2 should be the work of only one pupil.

Entries in categories 1 and 2 should be digitally photographed and sent by EMAIL to the organiser Mrs Linda Soames <u>lindasoames@home.3b.co.uk</u> who will forward them to the judges. The organiser is happy to receive the entries as a DROPBOX folder or pdf but would ask teachers to photograph each child's work as a separate picture.

Creative Writing entries written on computer may be sent as word documents. Where there is handwriting (especially if on coloured paper) we would ask teachers to make an accompanying typed copy as a word document.

DVD entries may be submitted via DROPBOX or on disc posted to the organiser who will supply, on request, an address.

PLEASE include, on a separate word document, a list of the Pupils' Names, Ages and Date of Birth together with the Name and Address of School and contact details of the teacher, including email.

Entries must be received by Monday 2nd MAY 2016 Winning schools to be notified during the week beginning 20th June 2016
